Report on Constitution Day Program

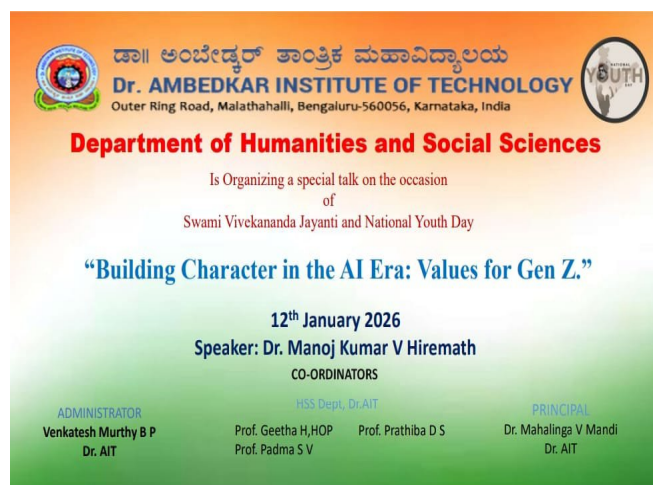

The session was delivered by **Dr. Manoj Kumar V. Hiremath, KLE Law College, Bengaluru**, on the topic *“Enduring Vision of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in the AI Age.”* The speaker explained the importance of the Constitution as the foundation of the nation and highlighted the vision of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in ensuring justice, equality, and liberty for all citizens.
