Agenda 2: Action taken report on the Minutes of 2^{nd} IQAC Meeting held on 11-06-2018

With the permission of Chairman of IQAC, Dr. M. Meenakshi, Coordinator of IQAC presented the action taken report on minutes of second IQAC meeting held on 11.06.2018.

Agenda 3: Submission of AQAR

Dr. Meenakshi, Coordinator of IQAC committee presented the Draft Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2017-18. While reviewing the AQAR report, the members have suggested the following points.

- To conduct online exam for the academic year 2018-19 for odd semester (1st, 3rd, 5th & 7th semester) by internal examiners and moderate evaluation of 10% randomly by external examiners to reduce the financial burden.
- Introduction of online courses compulsorily by identifying the elective subjects which can be introduced as Self Study Component for the academic year 2018-19 under the platform of Massive Open Online Course (MOOC), Study Webs of Active -Learning for Young Aspiring Minds (SWAYAM). The teacher has to monitor the students learning capabilities by facilitating one-hour weekly contact class. The teacher has to guide the students by giving them the title, syllabus content, etc. and

- evaluation is by conducting CIE and SEE. This has to be ratified in the Academic Council Meeting.
- To make effort to establish laboratories by the industries like L&T, Bosch, Shobha, Siemens, etc. that enhances the confidence of the students towards the institution.
- Improvement in Research & Development activities.
- To include the R&D Co-ordinator in IQAC. All the Research & Development activities data to be maintained in the IQAC.
- To present the achievements of the institution at the beginning of the next IQAC meeting.
- To plan for Ruby Jubilee celebration by organising International Conference and series of other activities. Also informed to prepare an Action Plan including all the activities
- To keep a benchmark of NIRF ranking and R&D activities.
- To draw the Road map of Dr. AIT and to focus to reach the goal.
- To create awareness of MOOC among the students by organising awareness program.
- To verify the IQAR report thoroughly before submitting to NAAC web portal.
- Procurement of computers by utilising the TEQIP-III fund.
- Motivate all the students to write GATE Exam by Career Guidance Cell and rename the TPC (Training & Placement Cell as Career Guidance Cell).
- To maintain the placement data by collecting the off campus and selfemployed information of the passed-out students. In this regard, informed to track and trap the students by google group.
- To make effort to improve the students achievement in the field sports activities at national and international level.
- To reduce the NIL statement in the AQAR.
- Distribution of work by introducing Deans separately for
 1) Academic, 2) R&D 3) Administration and 4) Industry Institution
 Interaction (III) for better quality in all the activities.

• All the documents to be recorded and indexed and files to be maintained

at IQAC.

• It was suggested to generate the revenue by selling the Digital Valuation

system software.
