The Chairman welcomed the members of BOG to the meeting and requested the Principal to present the agenda. The Co-ordinator, TEQIP-III Dr. Mahalinga V. Mandi sought for the confirmation of the proceedings of previous meeting held on 15.06.2019.

Dr.Shivaprakash, member congratulated the members of BoG, TEQIP-III officials and HoD's for achieving the distinction of a high performing institution in India. He also mentioned that Dr. AIT is one among 18 institutions which are selected as high performing institutions by NPIU.

While discussing the action taken report Dr. Shivaprakash, member suggested to submit a consolidated report of EAP before 10th July, 2019 and he also suggested to adopt a village to help it in terms of education, health, energy etc. In reply to this Principal informed that, a village has been identified in Magadi Taluk which is about 35 Kilometers from Bangalore, necessary arrangement will be made to adopt the village as a part of Institute Social Responsibility.

While discussing the action taken report Shri S Shivamallu, member suggested to draft policy guidelines for deputing faculty and staff members to attend training programs outside the institution before giving approval. The policy in this regard is to be submitted in the next BOG meeting. Dr. Shivaprakash, member suggested to depute faculty members to reputed institutions like IIT's, IIM's etc.

Dr. Shivaprakash, member expressed his displeasure at the low number of qualified GATE students. He agreed to the plan as suggested by the Principal, like organizing training classes by inviting GATE qualified research scholars from IISc and other reputed training institutions along with our GATE qualified faculty members. He also suggested to all the HOD's to create student awareness about the GATE exam and insist the students to take up GATE exam. Dr. B N Umesh, Member suggested to contact freelance service provider for GATE coaching.

Dr. Siddaraju, Nodal Officer Procurement informed the difficulty in procurement of books as it has to satisfy the requirements of NPIU. In this regard, Dr. Shivaprakash, member has suggested to take help of TATA Book House which is situated in IISc campus. He also suggested to become Institutional member for World e-library to get access to e-learning resources and e-Books.

Dr. Umesh B N, member suggested to setup a centralized R&D centre for students to work beyond college hours. Adding to this, Dr. Shivaprakash suggested to name it as Ideation/Innovation centre. The Principal suggested to call it as Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre.

With the above deliberations, the minutes of the meeting held on 15.06.2019 were read and confirmed.
